A. <u>Construction That Is Subject To This Review Procedure</u> - Any exterior construction, modification, repair or landscaping performed on subject lot.

B. Plans shall be submitted for approval in 2 phases:

1.) Construction Design Phase:

- completed Design Review Application
- 2 sets of Construction Plans

Site Plans (min scale 1/16" = 1') Specifications for all proposed clearing, grading, leveling, contouring, drainage and placement of improvements on subject lot, building footprint, entries, porches, balconies, overhangs, driveways, walks, and garden information. **Design Plans** (min scale 1/8' or greater = 1') Front, Sides, & Rear

Design Plans (min scale 1/8' or greater = 1') Front, Sides, & Rea Elevations, Floor Plans for each level, & Roof Plans

- Samples Paint Chips, Window (actual window or brochure), & Roofing
- **Review Fee -** \$350 for first 1.5 hour review and \$200 for each additional hour of review. Check made payable to Olde Towne Neighborhood Association.

Upon approval of Construction Design Phase, the application form will be marked approved and returned to applicant.

2.) Landscape Design Phase:

- Completed Landscape Design Application
- Sketches of all Areas to be improved

In the event plans, colors, or specifications are modified after approval, a new Design Review must be initiated by a separate application.

C. Applications shall be approved or denied based upon compliance with the following factors.

- Provisions of all documents listed in "B" of this document
- architectural style and design
- conformity with good design practices
- application of historically accurate design components
- scale of the proposed improvements
- aesthetic use of materials and the resulting extensor appearance
- quality of workmanship and material
- color selection
- relation of buildings to surrounding structures and topography
- avoidance of duplication or repetitive designs
- harmony of design with existing dwellings and other improvements
